



TRAVELLING WITH CYCLES & SCOOTERS

Keen to take your cycle or scooter on a Metlink bus, harbour ferry or train? Here's a guide to where and when it's possible, and a brief summary of other things you might like to know.

THE WHERE, WHEN AND HOW



Only compact scooters and fully folding cycles can go on buses, and maximum dimensions apply.



You can take your cycle or scooter on board Metlink trains free of charge. Note that:

- space is limited, so cycles are accepted on a first come, first served basis
- to determine if your bike is allowed on a peak service train, visit www.metlink.org.nz/getting-around
- fully folding cycles are allowed on all services.



The harbour ferries can normally take six to eight cycles per crossing, but this depends on how busy they are. If you're going with a group, call 04 499 1282 first to check that there's room.

NEED STORAGE?

Most railway stations offer cycle stands that are free to use. Other options include cycle cages and lockers, for which you need to pay a fee. There's a full list of the storage options at www.metlink.org.nz.
