



TRAVELLING WITH A SUPERGOLD CARD

Travel with Metlink and your SuperGold Card during off-peak hours and it won't cost you a cent!

You can use your SuperGold Card to travel for free on Metlink bus, train and harbour ferry services:

- on weekdays between 9am and 3pm, and after 6.30pm
- any time on weekends and public holidays.

Simply present your SuperGold card to the train staff, harbour ferry staff or bus driver.

If you don't have your SuperGold card with you or travel outside SuperGold off-peak hours you will need to pay for your journey.

PRIORITY SEATING FOR OLDER PEOPLE

All Metlink buses, trains and ferries have priority seating for older people.

Priority seating for seniors, parents with young children (under the age of 5) or prams and people with mobility problems, is available on Metlink trains and buses. It consists of four seats usually facing each other or facing the aisle, with a flat walkway that is close to the front door.

- arrange to arrive at your destination by a specified time.
