

Train ticket options.

We're saying goodbye to paper tickets and replacing them with the cheaper, faster and easier Snapper card.

The Snapper 30-day Rail pass is replacing the Rail Monthly and MonthlyPlus passes, which means you start your 30-day Rail pass when you tag on for your first trip!

- 10-trips are being phased out, but the Snapper fare will be the same as a 10-trip train fare.
- You can still pay for your journey with cash, but if you train with your Snapper card, it works out cheaper. In fact, a single trip with Snapper will be at least 25% less.
- Normal concessions apply, visit snapper.co.nz/concessions/ or call Snapper on 0800 555 345 to apply the concession to your card.
- If you're a SuperGold card holder, simply show your SuperGold card to staff when travelling as usual for free off-peak travel.

Paying with your Snapper card is easy, simply tag on and off for a cheaper, faster and easier trip.

Snapper card readers are located near the entrances and exits at train stations for an easy journey on the train.

Why do I need a Snapper card?

From 31 December 2022, we're saying goodbye to paper tickets across the rail network.

You will still be able to pay with cash for a single trip on board the train from 1 January 2023, but remember, paying with a Snapper card is at least 25% cheaper than the cash fare.

How do I get a Snapper card?

You might already have a Snapper card for your bus trips. A Total Mobility card or even some school student ID cards are Snapper cards in disguise - and are ready to use on the train.

If you don't have a Snapper card you can buy one from a Snapper retailer, the Snapper website, or the ticket window at Wellington Railway Station. Visit snapper.co.nz to find your nearest option.

When you have your Snapper card, simply top it up at a Snapper retailer, kiosk, at the ticket window at Wellington Railway Station or use the Snapper iOS app on iPhone 7 / iOS 13 and above, or the Android app with NFC smartphones.
